




The Ring 96, Victor Cohn, Magic Estate Sale (Episode 13)

Leather Kattee Wallet \$15


This leather wallet from Kattee does not appear gimmicked. It does have a few scratches, but is still very usable and very nice.



Pencil Through Quarter



This is a two deck matching deck effect that has two spectators somehow match up when dealing cards. Several alternative options and an upgrade are included in this effect!



2 foot square \$10 gold fabric

If you hold this beautiful piece of finished gold fabric the right way, no one will ever



see the gimmick which can probably hold an awful lot.

Cardboard treasure chest. \$5

Ahoy Matey! There be no treasure in this chest unless you put it in. A fine prop for a pirate routine. About 14 inches wide, and maybe eight inches deep and eight inches high. In good condition.



\$10 Fanning Deck (Autographed by designer)

This deck will look great when you do your fanning routines. Get it while you can. Box has been autographed by the designer.



\$10 Jim Greene's Condensed Water Effect

Pour water into two shot glasses. They are both the same right? Can you condense water? Not according to the laws of Physics you can't. According to the laws of magic you might get a different answer. Everything you need is here. Never been used.

Elusive Elephant (Card pack unopened) \$20

Three jumbo cards are introduced, one with a circus elephant and two which display a colored ball on each.

The elephant and one of the balls are turned with their back to the audience and the card showing the second ball is placed inside an envelope which can be shown empty. The two cards left in the hand are mixed and then a spectator gets a chance to guess which one is the elephant. No matter which card he selects, he is wrong! This can be repeated at will.

Later, much to everyone's surprise the elephant will be found in the envelope.



Endgame \$10

You introduce a deck and a small packet of "mystery cards". A card is selected from the deck, it is signed and the lost back in the deck. The "mystery cards" are now used to decide on how the trick will end.

One of the "mystery cards" is selected by a spectator and the remaining are turned over to reveal other possible endings. 'Card In Box', 'Card In My Pocket' etc.



The selected ending is turned over to reveal - the spectators signed card.

\$20 Patriotic Blendo

Start off with one small red silk, white silk, and blue silk. Do your miracles as you like but watch as the flag comes out in several mis made ways. Finally the full size flag arrives. There are a total of 12 silks here.



\$10 Domino Delight (from Suds)

Have the spectator spread out the included dominos in a line. Open the included envelope. You will have predicted what numbers are on each end of the line. This is close-up size and a real winner!
